- * needs for primary health care on family violence in different cultural settings at WONCA Africa conference (Ghana, 6-7 May 2015)
- * defining research priorities and strategy on family violence at EGRRN meeting (Timisoara, 9 May 2015)
- * training the trainers and implementation of national strategies against family violence planned for the WONCA Europe conference (Istanbul, 21-25 Oct 2015)
